Safer Travel to Jersey



Before your travel to Jersey:

All passengers arriving in Jersey MUST complete a registration form before they travel. If you haven't already, do it now.

Passengers who fail to complete a form will face significant delays upon arrival.

On arrival in Jersey

Car passengers remain in your car and follow instructions, which will depend on whether you:

Do not take a test

(14 day self-isolation)

If you do not want to be tested, you MUST self-isolate for 14 days. Failure to self-isolate is a criminal offence and punishable by a fine of up to £1,000.

Take a test

This procedure will involve a swab being taken from the back of your throat and nose.

Waiting for your results

You can expect to receive your test result within 48 hours. You are not required to selfisolate while waiting for your test results but MUST follow Jersey's Public Health guidance.

Positive COVID-19 test results

If your test is positive, the Contact Tracing Team will call you with guidance on support available.

You MUST immediately self-isolate.

Negative COVID-19 test result

If your test is negative, you will receive a text message to let you know. You will be contacted by the Contact Tracing Team regularly to monitor your symptoms for up to 14 days.
